First Great Lesson: Coming of the Universe

Students will be studying the age of the universe and earth and the formation of the solar system including the layers of elements in stars. This study will lead into the introduction of the periodic table and all that it entails. They will also be using science

experiments in the classroom to reinforce the concept of the Laws of the Universe.

Biology: The Five Kingdoms
